No Rate Increase for 2024 and Project Update

We are not planning a rate increase for 2024. There are pressures that are affecting operations and there are changes coming with our G&T, but these changes won't affect rate this year.

Other major projects that will be in the works for the new year are a continuation of the and North project Worland upgrading infrastructure for increased loads. In the Casper District, the crews are working around the Alcova Reservoir, converting to underground to refeed and balance the loads in that area.

There are additional projects across our territory designed to transition from overhead to underground service. Moving lines from overhead to underground serves several purposes. Transitioning to underground supports HPP's fire mitigation plan. It also increases the reliability of electrical service, protecting lines from wind and ice and other natural phenomena.

HPP is also implementing an Advanced Data Management System (ADMS) for our substations. This new system will enable HPP to collect more assist data to with load analysis and troubleshooting monitoring and of the substations in our territory.

At the legislative level, there has been discussion and review of certificated territories. Certificated areas are important for providing stability, infrastructure and service reliability. HPP will continue to be a proactive voice, supporting cooperatives throughout the state.

Another project in the works is for 30 miles of transmission line to be rebuilt from Pilot Butte to Burris Lenore.

BEEFY CORN AND BLACK BEAN CHILI
